Thomas Guerrero (USA)



Thomas Guerrero started dancing socially in 1994. He was recruited from the social scene by Wilton Beltre in 1995 and became one of the original members of *Santo Rico Dance Co.* Upon being recruited Thomas had no prior dance training. Most of his training came through learning choreography and eventually performing with *Santo Rico Dance Co.*

As a professional dancer Thomas, now Director and President of *Santo Rico*, has only danced for said company, from their first local performance at «*Gozamba*», a Dominican Festival in Washington Heights, NY, to teaching and performing at venues across the country, spanning 3 continents and over 11 countries. Thomas' achievements involve becoming one of the leading stars of the world famous off-Broadway Comedy Dancical, «*Latin Madness*», and also performed alongside several Salsa superstars, like Tito Puente, Marc Anthony, Gilberto Santa Rosa, Víctor Manuelle, Raulín Rosendo, José Alberto «El Canario», Johnny Pacheco, Norman Headman, and performing and choreographing for Hip Hop Superstar Eve's video of her hit single, «*What Y'all Want*» 2000. Thomas is also the pioneer of the world-famous «*Santo Rico*» spinning technique. Thomas and *Santo Rico Dance Co.* recently returned from their most recent Asia tour in Tokyo, Japan, Hong Kong and Korea, and are preparing to embark on other prestigious world tours for 2005.

Ahtoy Wonpat-Borja (USA)



Ahtoy was raised for a career in dance since childhood as she studied Ballet, Jazz, and Modern dance in Guam and intermittently with the Houston and San Francisco Ballet companies. She was also a competitive Latin and Ballroom dancer in the collegiate circuit. Ahtoy's performance experience extends from dance to musical theater where she has held key roles in Guam and in New York. Ahtoy's Mambo training, however, has come from *Santo Rico Dance School*. Upon joining *Santo Rico* Ahtoy emerged as one of its top

students and was invited to train with the school's semi-pro team, «*Xibicion*» *Santo Rico* where she eventually also became co-captain of the team and the girl's coach of their styling and spinning technique, and performed at some of New York City's top events as a part of *Xibicion*.

She is currently dancing with *Santo Rico*'s professional dance team, but is still coaching the semi-pro team's girls.

Félix Torres (Cuba)

Félix graduated from the *Narcizo Medina Dance School* as a professional dancer. Now he is dancing, also as a soloist, in the very well known *Conjunto Folklórico Nacional de Cuba* that is specialized in Cuban folkloristic dances. *Conjunto Folklórico Nacional de Cuba* also does everything from salsa to rumba. Félix is studying in *ISA* (Instituto Superior de Arte), The Superior Institute of Arts. He is graduating as a professional dance teacher.

Miguel Verdecia (Cuba — Finland)



Professional dancer, teacher and choreographer. In December of 1993 he established first salsa school in Finland — *Baila Baila* (Helsinki) where he teaches salsa, merengue, cha-cha-chá, mambo, conga, son and rueda de casino. In 1993 Miguel was named *The best dancer of the year* by *City* magazine. He performed on TV making salsa popular in Finland. Miguel is the winner of «*Nordic salsa championship*» in 2001 and 2004. He also teaches and performs abroad, for example, he is a constant participant of salsa congresses in

St. Petersburg.

Carlos Correa (Cuba — Finland)



Carlos Correa was born in Havana (Cuba). The sounds of claves and timbales were never far from him so it was just a matter of time that he would learn how to dance salsa music. He took his first dancing steps at a very young stage of his life and as he grew up got a taste of the real feeling on the streets of Havana.

Carlos moved to Europe over 15 years ago where he developed the already existing dancing skills. At the moment he lives in Helsinki (Finland) and works as a salsa teacher in the biggest and most prestigious salsa dancing school in the country (*Baila Baila*) for the last 10 years now. Carlos is one of the responsible for the development of salsa dance not only in Finland but also in other neighboring countries; he has taken part in numerous salsa Congresses as a performer, instructor and jury. His passion is Rueda de Casino and Carlos has taken it to a new dimension creating a variety of movement and figures of his own which has made him a very popular Rueda instructor.
